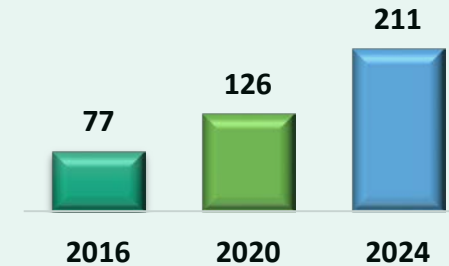

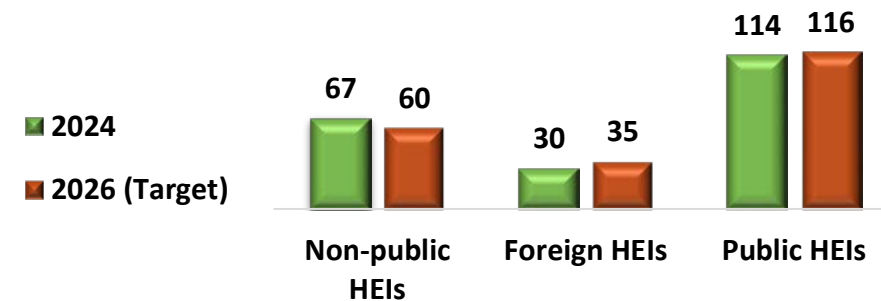
## OVERALL NUMBER OF HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS (HEIs) – 211

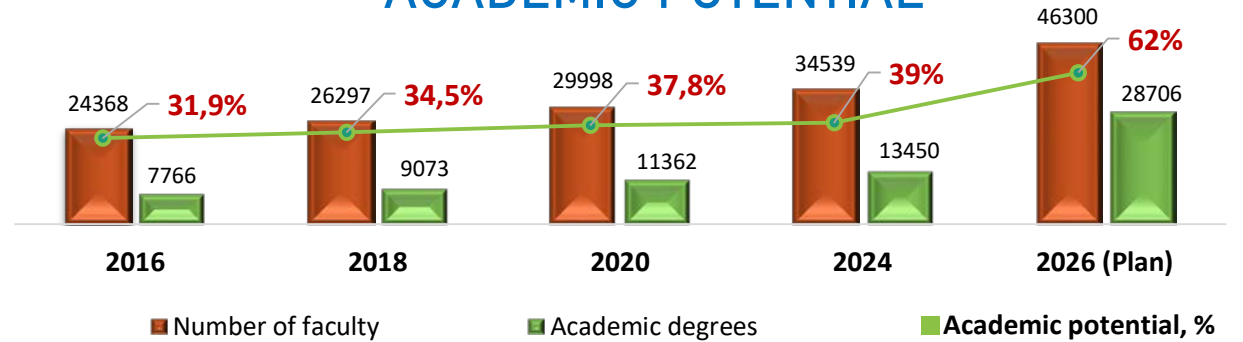

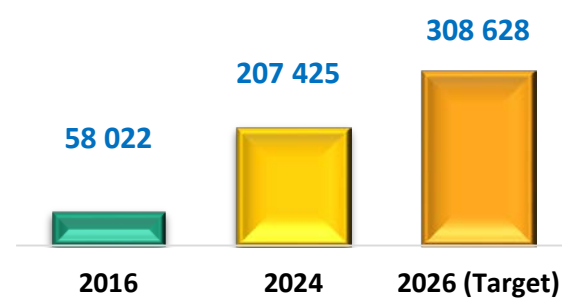

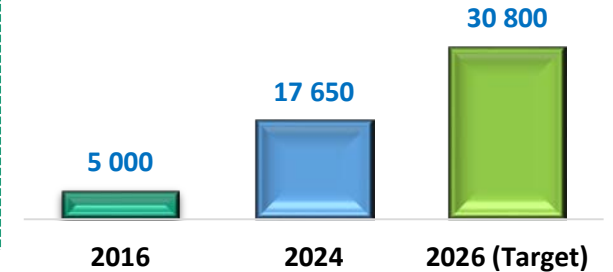


## ENROLLMENT RATE IN HIGHER EDUCATION

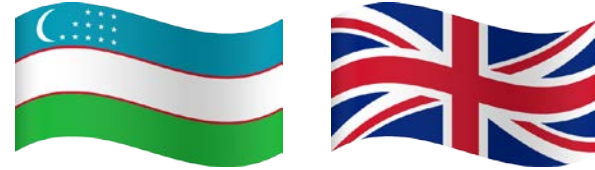
