- Founded in 1838 as the first Polytechnic Institution in London with a mission to educate the working people of London
- Our Mission today is to help students and colleagues from different backgrounds fulfil their potential and contribute to a more sustainable, equitable and healthier society
- Gained University status in 1992
- We support 22,000 students on our Undergraduate, Postgraduate and Professional courses
- Central London Location with campuses in Regent Street, Marylebone, Cavendish and Harrow
- Our University has a long and proud history of global engagement, international collaboration and educating international students.
- 30% of our undergraduate students and 70% of our postgraduate students are drawn from over 160 countries.

- Founded as a collaboration between the University of Westminster and the Foundation of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan in 2002
- First international University in Uzbekistan
- Distinctive model of Transnational Education
- Developed from a capacity building project
- In 2022 we celebrated our 20th anniversary

- 22 years ago the British Council circulated a call for UK institutions who would be interested in supporting building project in Uzbekistan
- The then Vice-Chancellor was keen for the University to be involved in an exciting opportunity to help develop the educational opportunities for the population of Uzbekistan
- The opportunity to be the first in the region was exciting
- There was a stringent application process and against competition from others we were successful
- Outcome: University of Westminster founded Westminster International University in Tashkent (WIUT) in 2002.
