



### **HEIs in Uzbekistan**




#### Main peculiarities:

All HEIs: Rather narrow specialization

TNE:

- teaching oriented
- mostly IT, educational and business subject areas

Government support in STEM-based engineering and science universities within industrial clusters


Stand-alone central universities in STEM subjects

Private HEIs leave international partner accreditation for local curriculum


Private HEIs' dilemma – Profit vs Quality
