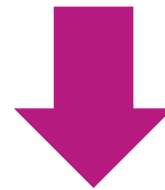

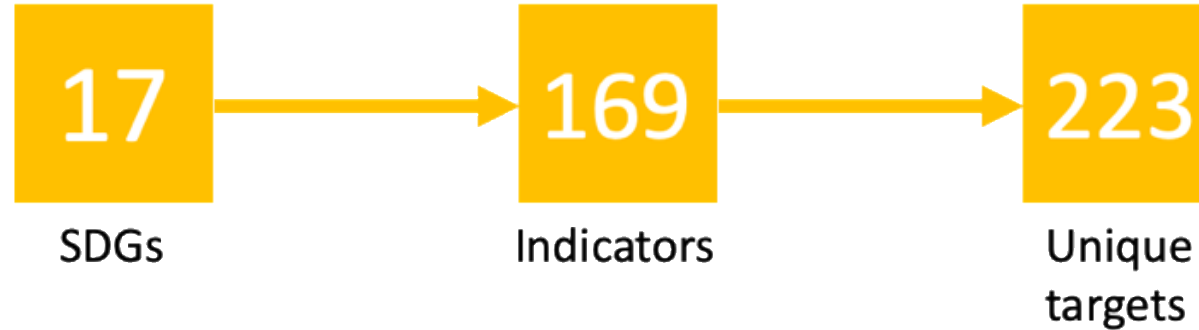

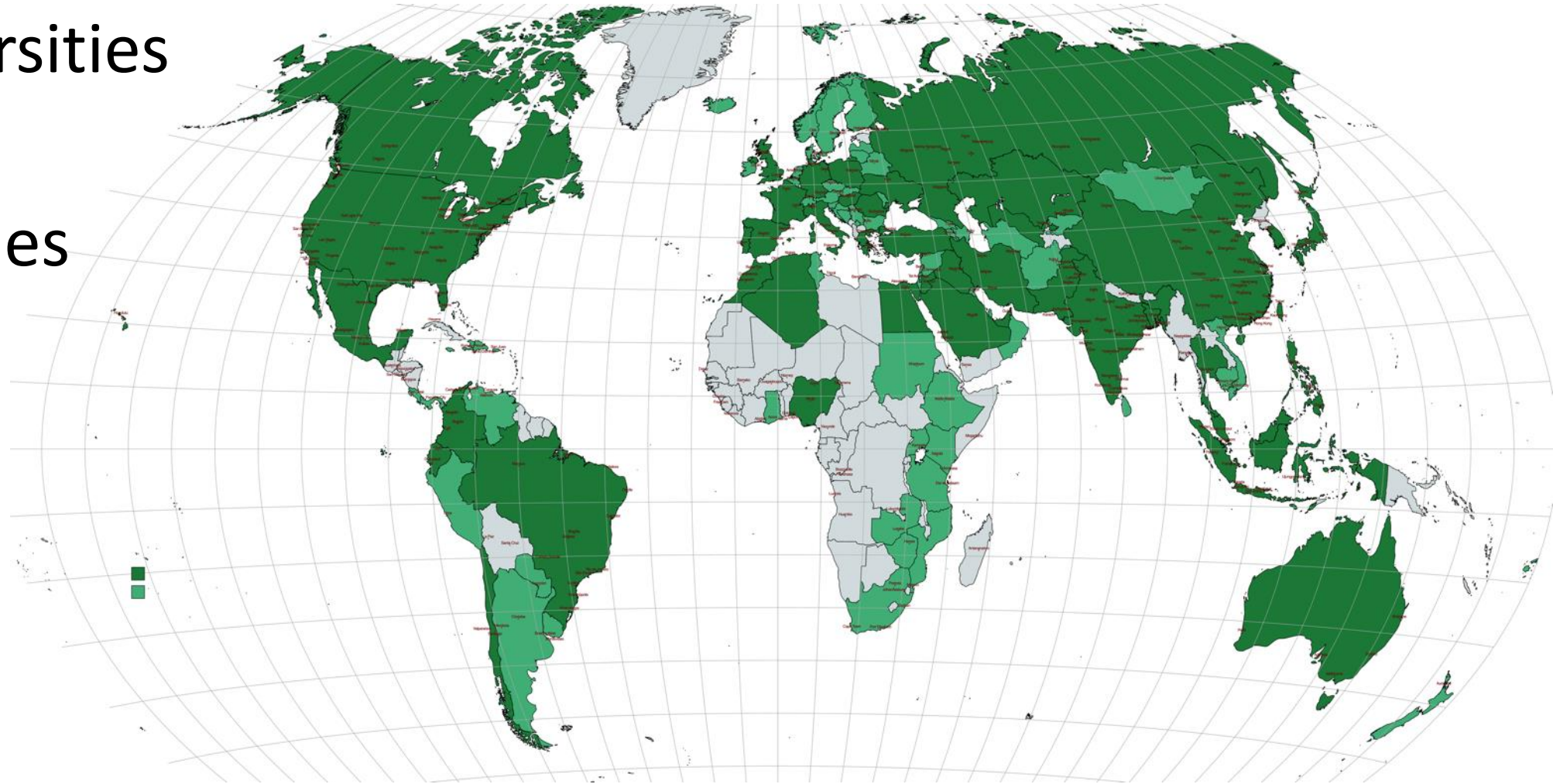

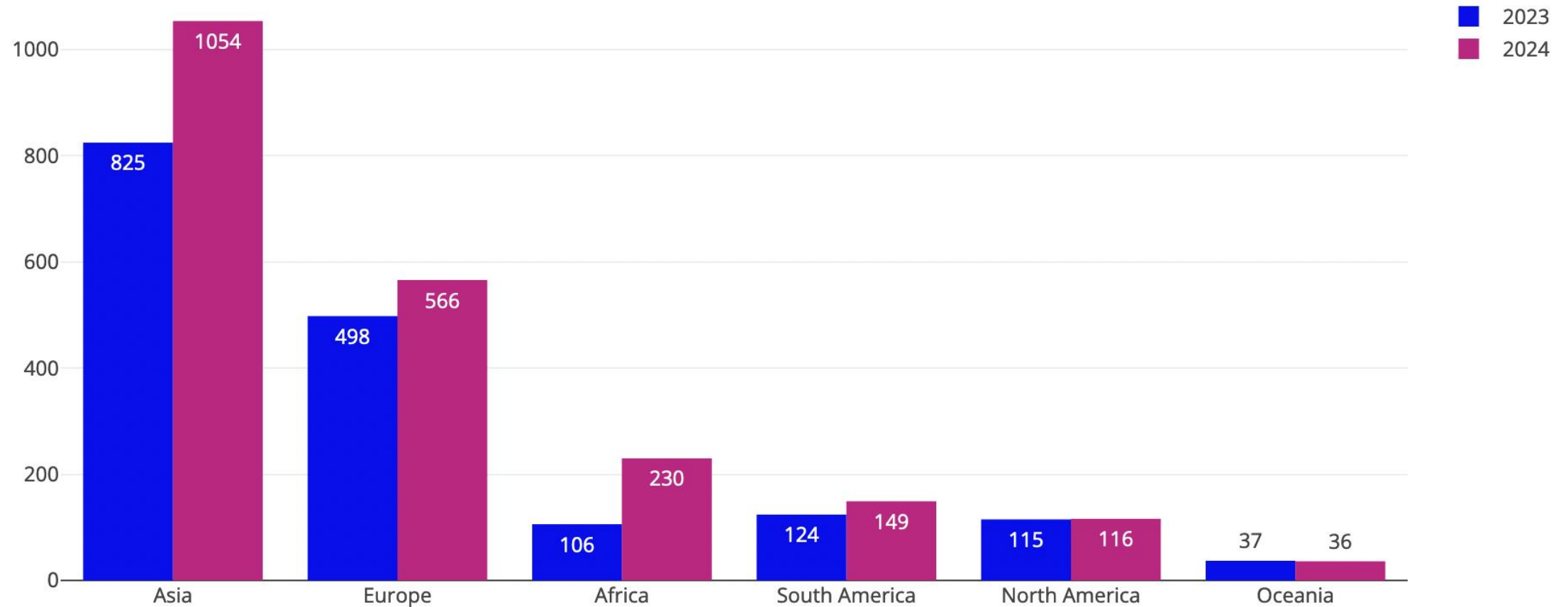

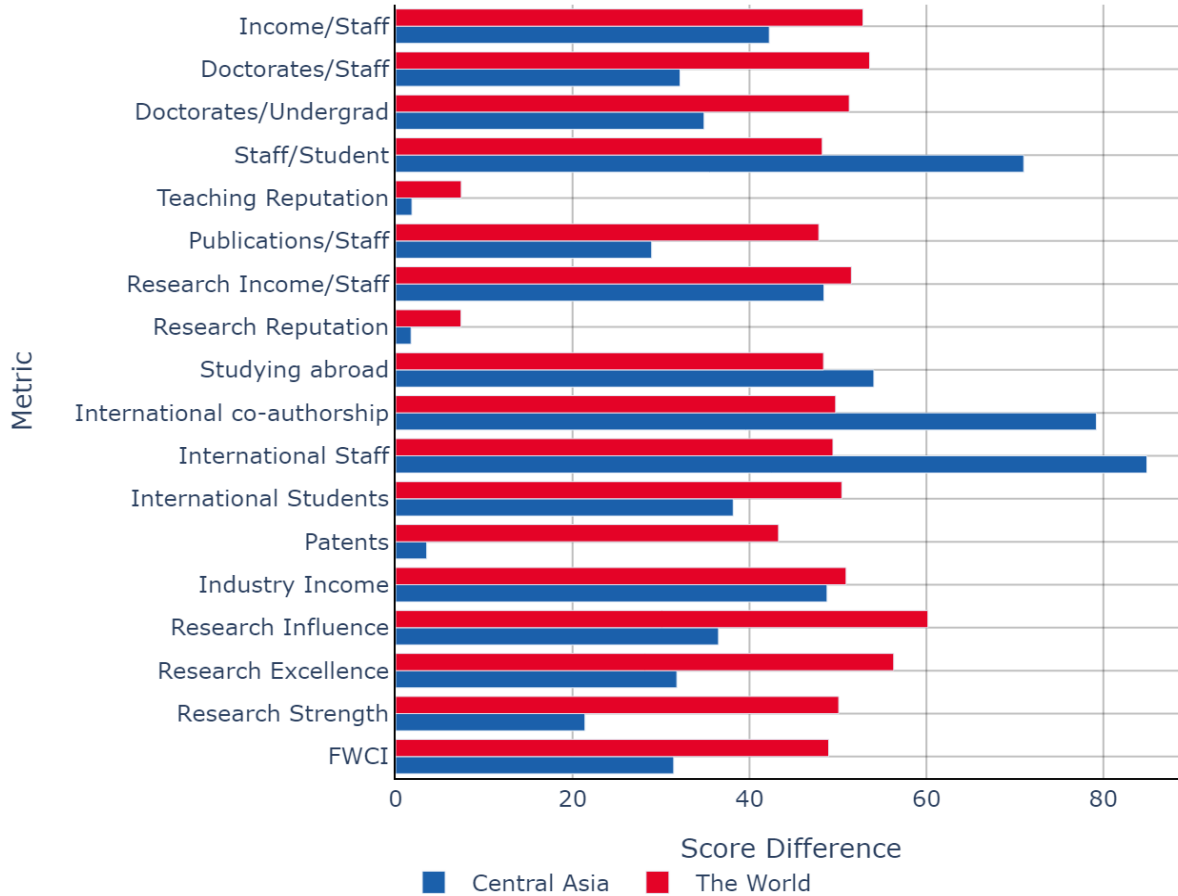
Central Asia Overview with a focus on Uzbekistan



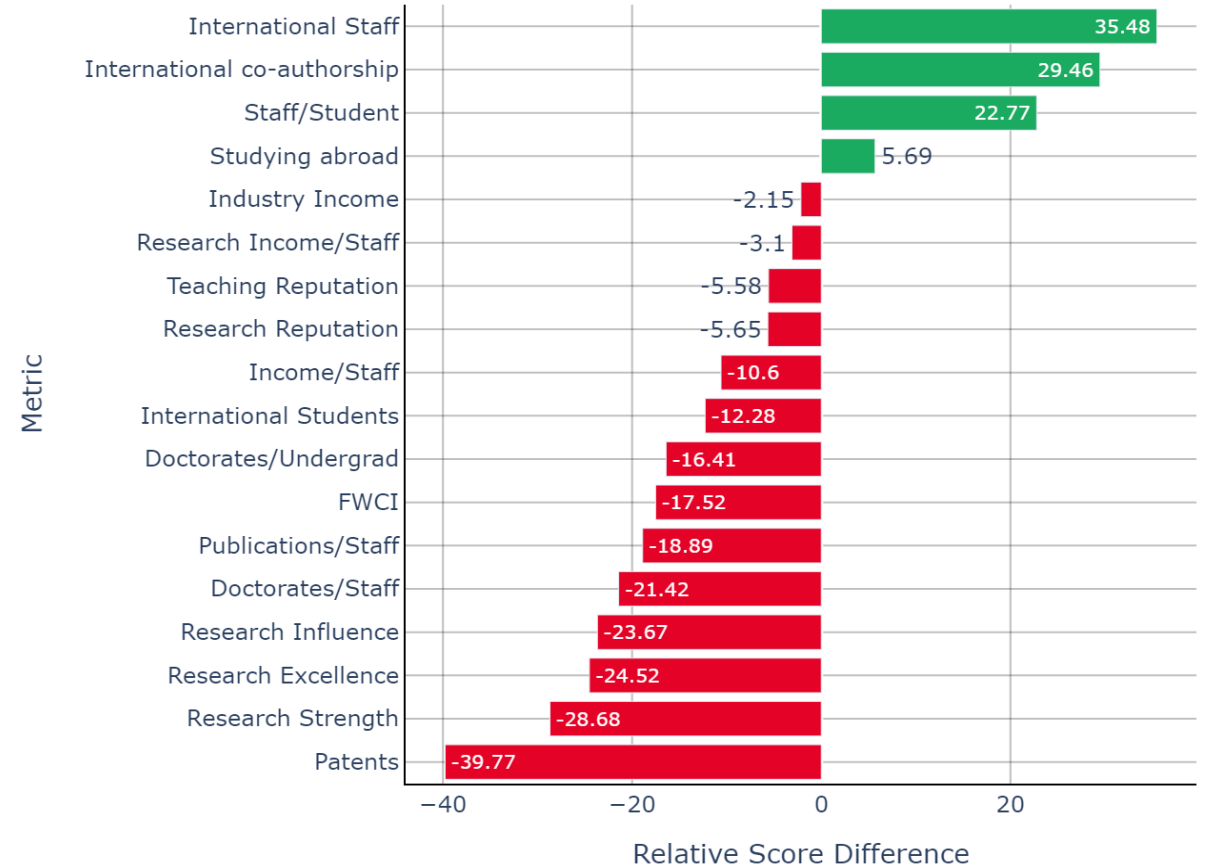
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Central Asia vs The World 2024 Metric Differences

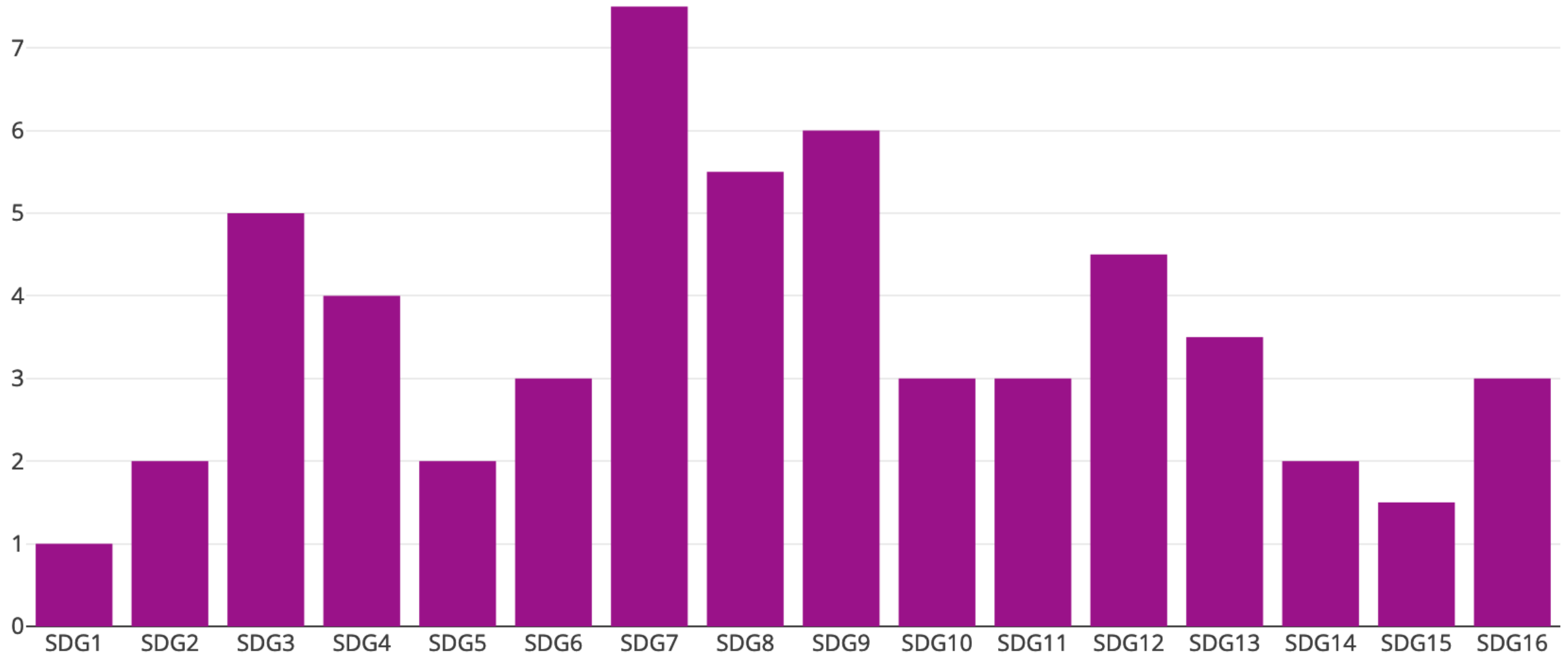
Central Asia vs The World Metric Score Difference 2024



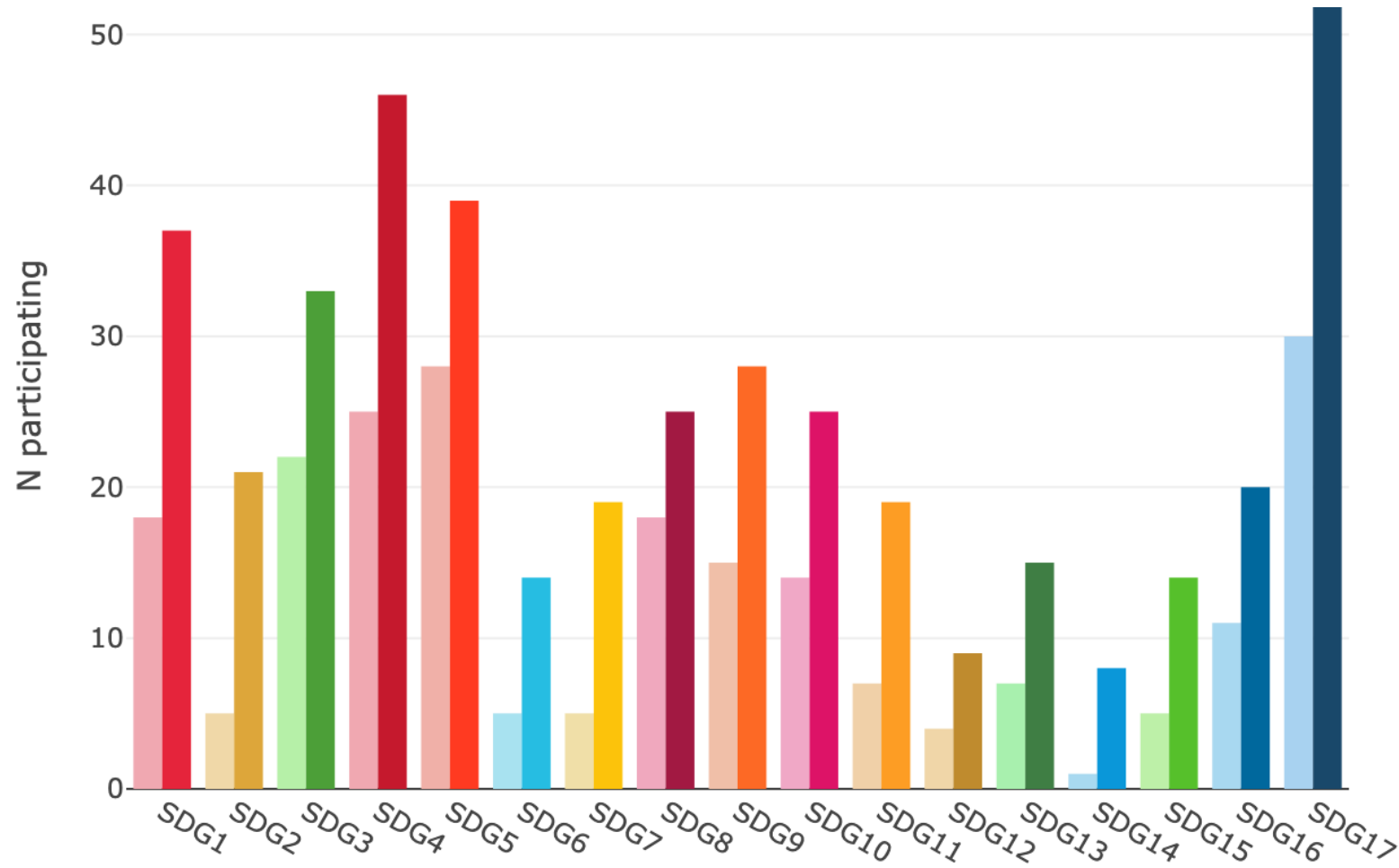
Central Asia vs The World Metric Relative Score Difference 2024



Central Asia, total output per SDG (median)

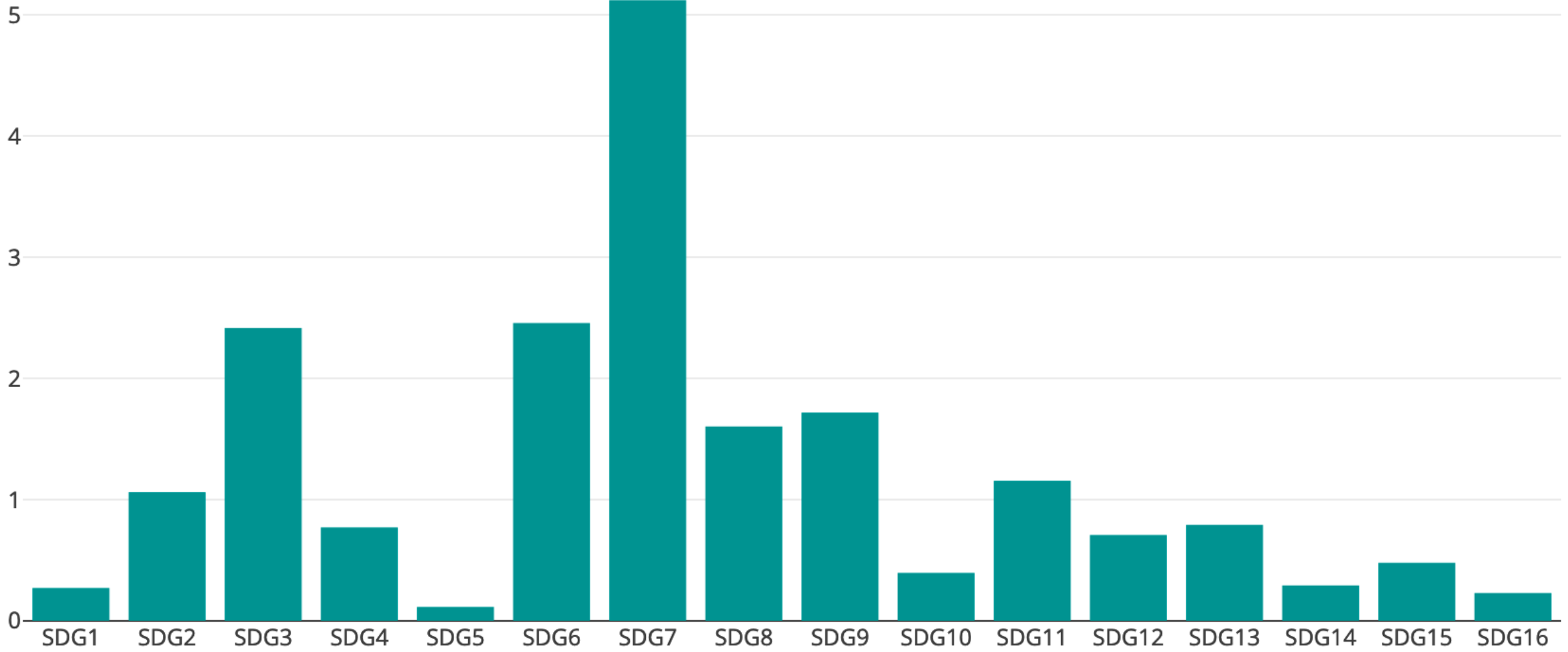


Number of institutions from Uzbekistan participating in 2022 and 2023

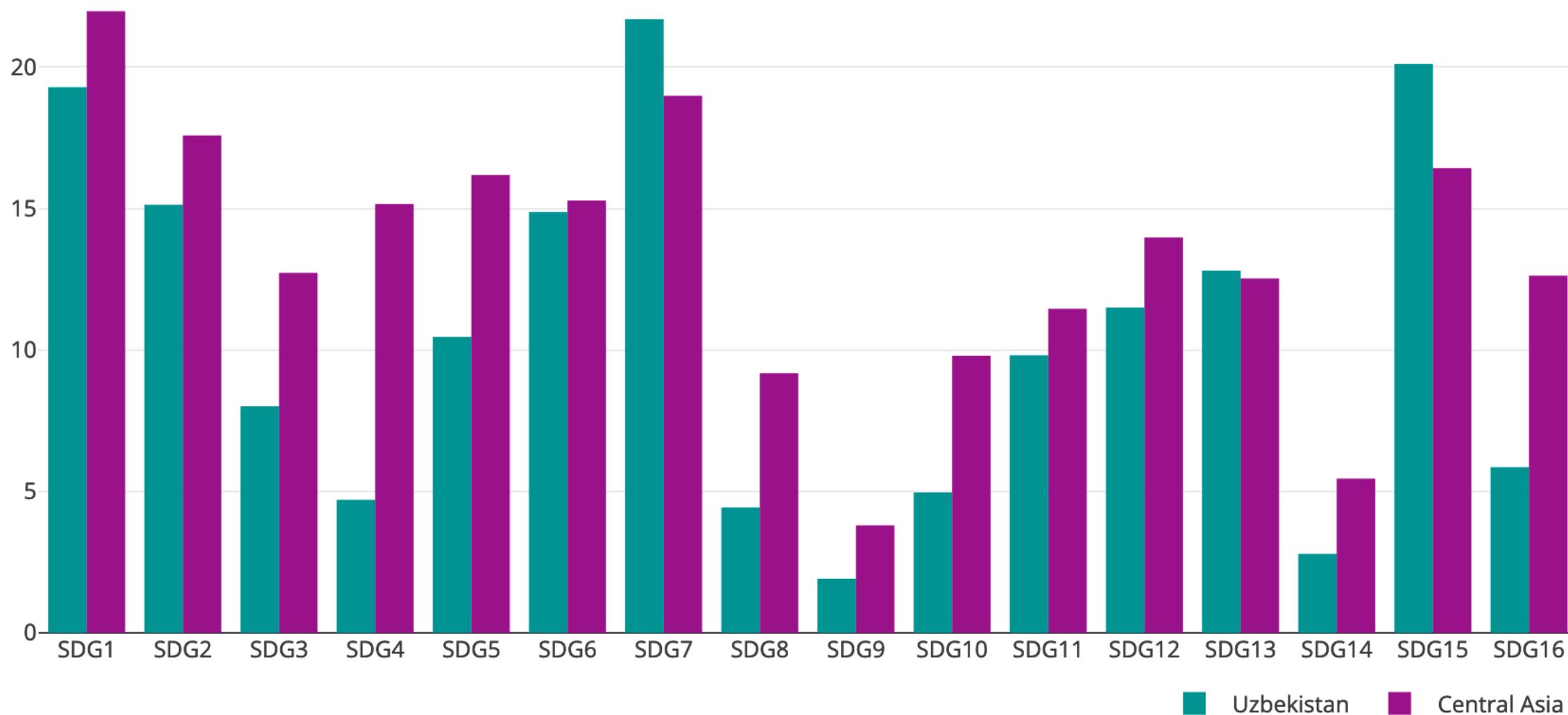


A total of 30 institutions from Uzbekistan submitted to the Impact ranking in 2022 and 53 in 2023 (an increase of 76.7%).

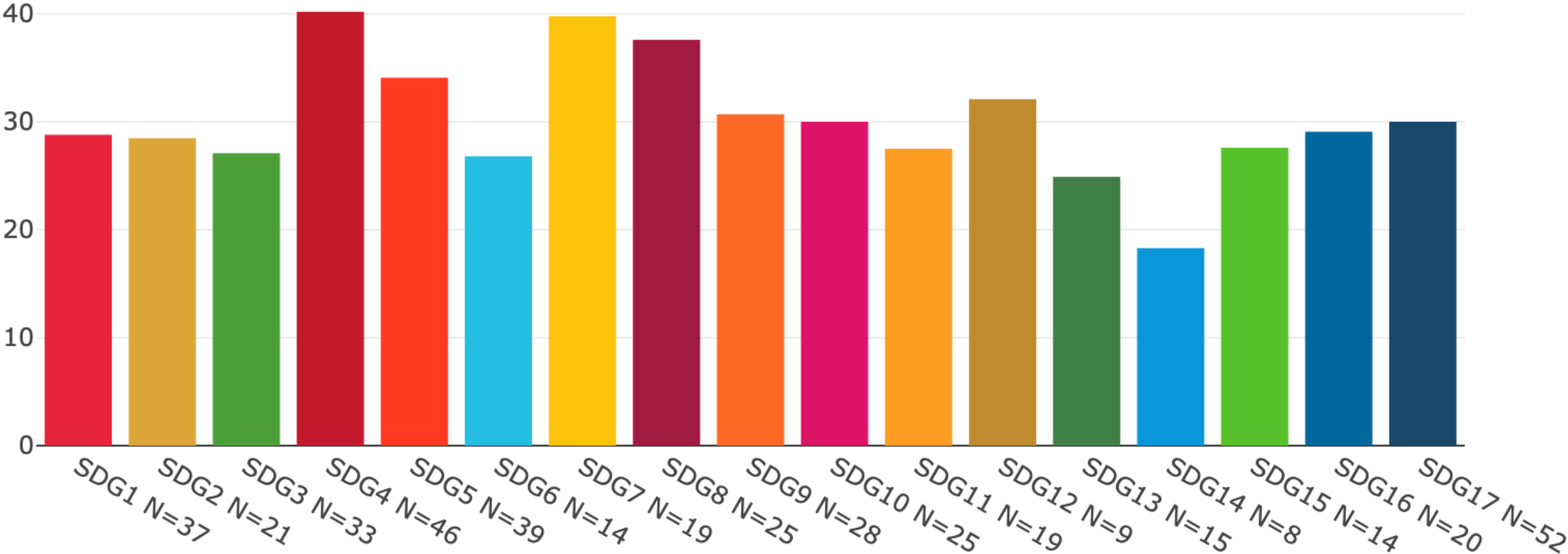
Uzbekistan, total output per SDG (median)



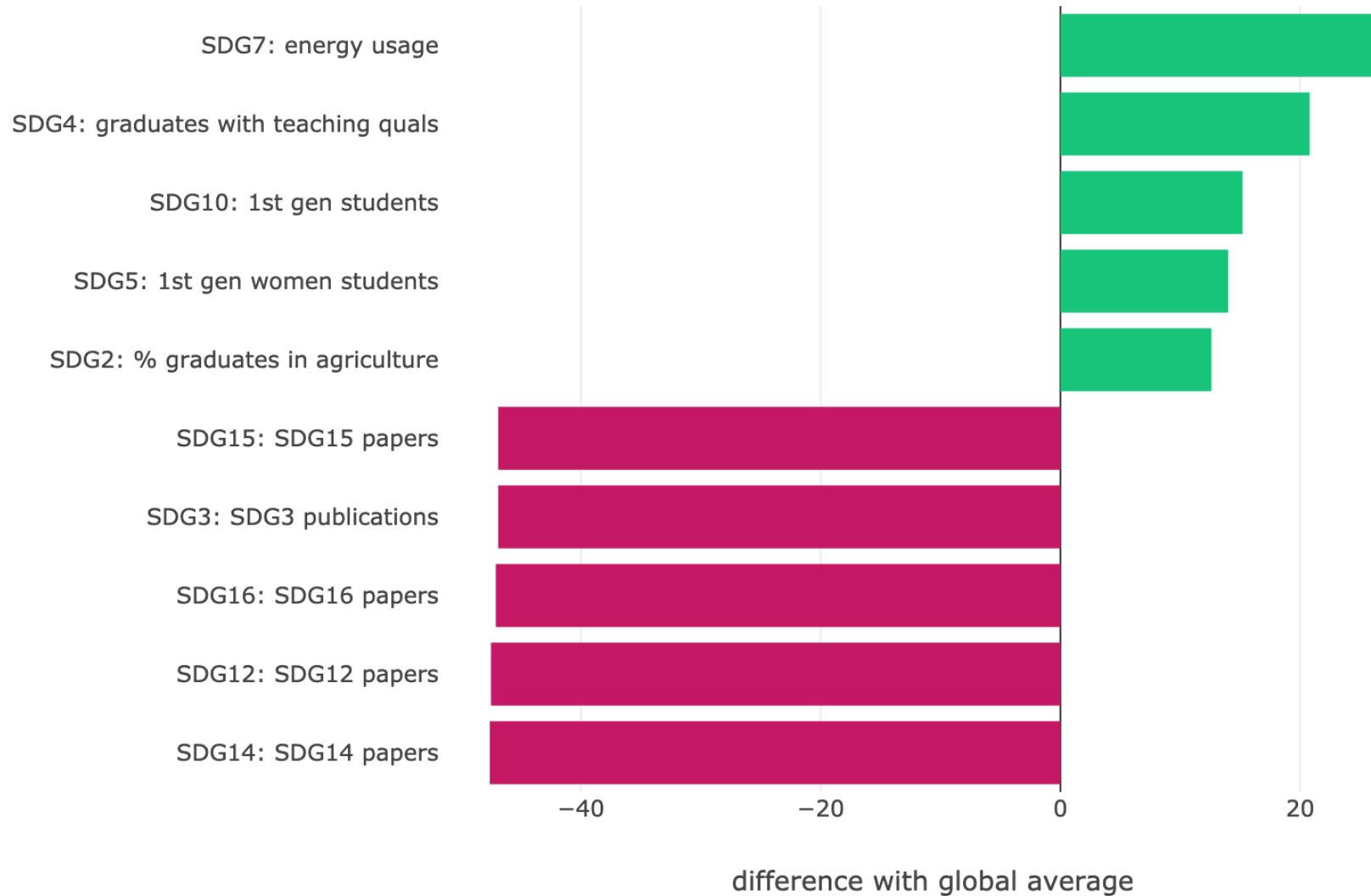
Average Research scores per SDG



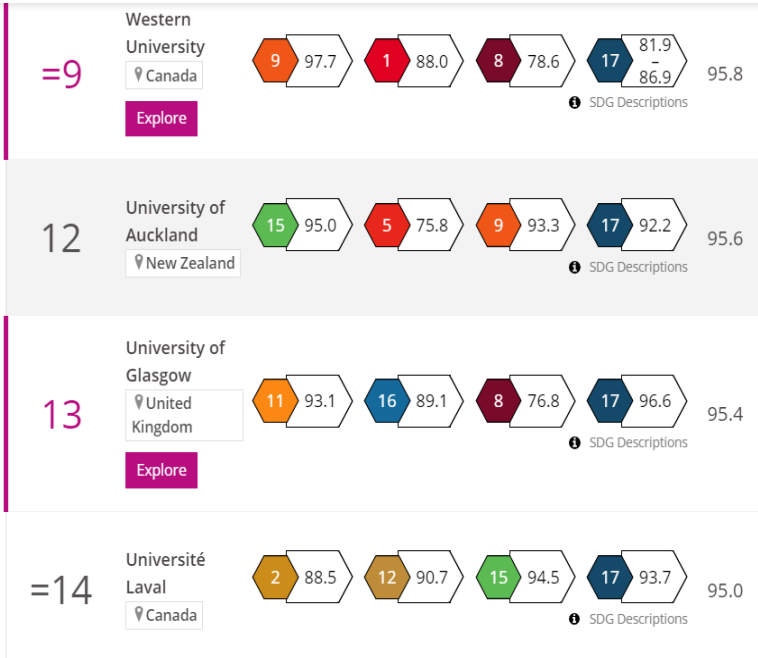
Average score for Uzbekistan institutions per SDG

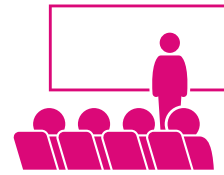
